Remark : 1. Admission fee is not refundable in any case.

2. Type 1.1 : Thesis not less than 48 credits

3. Type 2.1 : Thesis 36 credits and Coursework not less than 12 credits

2. Qualifications of Applicants

2.1 General Qualification

Doctoral Degree

1) Applicants must hold a Bachelor's degree or the equivalent with an excellent grade; or a Master's degree or the equivalent or currently be enrolled in a master's degree or equivalent program and expected to graduate before the beginning of the second semester of the academic year 2025, and meet the program qualification. Applicants must have the requirement of the English language proficiency standard test according to the Announcement of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University.

2) Applicants must have other qualifications in accordance with the regulation of Chiang Mai Rajabhat University regarding the Graduate Studies, 2018 and/or any subsequent amendments.

2.2 Program Qualifications

Doctor of Philosophy in Business Administration

Type 1.1

1) Applicants must hold a Master's degree or equivalent in a field related to Business Administration from a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI). The Master's degree GPA must be no less than 3.00.

2) Applicants must have at least 2 years of work experience in research or possess demonstrable achievements in the field of Business Administration.

3) Applicants who do not meet the above qualifications may be considered at the discretion of the Program Committee and in accordance with the university's admission announcement.

Type 2.1

1) Applicants must hold a Master's degree in any field from a higher education institution accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, Research and Innovation (MHESI). The Master's degree GPA must be no less than 3.00.

2) Applicants must have at least 1 year of work experience in a public or private organization.

3) Applicants who do not meet the above qualifications may be considered at the discretion of the Program Committee and in accordance with the university's admission announcement.

3. Application

Qualified applicants who meet the requirements may apply online and upload the certified required documents through the Graduate School website <https://www.graduate.cmru.ac.th> between Wednesday, August 6, 2025, and Wednesday, September 24, 2025.

Required Documents:

- 1) 1 Photograph (not more than 2 MB) (.jpeg)
- 2) 1 Transcript in Thai or English (.pdf)
- 3) 1 Copies of National identification card or passport (.pdf)
- 4) 1 Certified copy of name/surname change certificate (if any) (.pdf)
- 5) 1 English proficiency official report (.pdf)

Applicants wishing to enroll must submit English proficiency test scores as specified in the table below to be exempt from registering for English courses at the doctoral level. The English test scores must be valid for no more than 2 years from the date the scores were reported until the application submission date. However, applicants whose English test scores do not meet the specified criteria may still be admitted but will be required to register for English courses and achieve a passing evaluation according to the university's criteria.
